

Update: Sahara is doing great and so are her puppies!

On March 13, we got a call from Tina Kiel at Precision Furniture Installation about a pregnant dog with a steel trap attached to her back leg. The dog was named Sahara and her rescue story was broadcast on several television stations. The picture at right is of Sahara inside our rescue vehicle and soon to be on her way to Dr. Ed's. When rescued, you could see her back bones as well as her ribs despite being hugely pregnant. We have no idea why she is missing an ear and when rescued, didn't realize she had also been shot and was suffering from heartworms.



We wanted everyone to know, that Sahara is currently in a foster home with Tina and getting along well with the other dogs and cats in her home. On March 30 she gave birth to 11 puppies and all are doing well.

Dr. Ed reports that he doesn't have to remove the bullet from her back and it appears that her leg and foot will heal on its own. We are thrilled that she won't lose her leg. Once her puppies are weaned, she will be treated for her heartworms, spayed and found a loving home.
